It would require certain secured firearm storage or trigger-locks and criminalize certain firearm storage if it results in unauthorized use.

MARGIN OF ERROR

405 registered voters, selected at random from registered voter lists in the State of Washington, were interviewed October 4-9 by live, professional interviewers. 44% of the interviews were conducted on cell phones. The margin of sampling error is $\pm 5\%$ at the 95% level of confidence. This means, in theory, that had this same survey been conducted 100 times, the results would be within $\pm 5\%$ of the results reported here at least 95 times.
