## MARGIN OF ERROR

405 registered voters, selected at random from registered voter lists in the State of Washington, were interviewed October 4-9 by live, professional interviewers. $44 \%$ of the interviews were conducted on cell phones. The margin of sampling error is $\pm 5 \%$ at the $95 \%$ level of confidence. This means, in theory, that had this same survey been conducted 100 times, the results would be within $\pm 5 \%$ of the results reported here at least 95 times.
