81% of the eligible voters contacted initially said they would vote in the Primary

2. [ASKED OF 437] In order for your ballot to be counted, you must check a box on the return envelop declaring that your party preference is the Democratic Party. That declaration becomes public record. Given that, would you say you will:

80% Definitely vote in the Democratic primary
13% Probably vote

93% of those who initially said they would vote still said they would vote when told their party preference would be make public
 20% of those who initially said they would vote were less than "definite" voters

- Of the eligible voters initially contacted
 65% said they would "definitely" vote;
 11% said they would "probably" vote in the primary
