A proposal before the legislature to address climate change would impose a **cap on the amount of greenhouse gas** a company or organization could release into the atmosphere. That cap would be lowered over time to help Washington reach zero emissions by 2050.

It would also create a marketplace where companies over their emission limit could buy pollution credits from another company that is under its limit. This plan is called cap-and-trade. It would generate \$600 million to \$1 billion dollars per year that would be invested in clean energy and environmental justice programs, as well as other programs to combat climate change.
