"I am for a white mans pacific coast" and it will be located outside in the drained pool west of the entrance doors.

The text piece by Jim Snowden will be at BAM on a flier that sits in a real estate brochure style box and the text has changed.

Erin's paper mache sculptures will have the text:

Born January 27th 1994, the 282nd child born incarcerated at the Minidoka Concentration Camp, Hunt, Idaho. A healthy boy delivered by a horse veterinarian.

On this site, Bellevue City Hall and surrounding lands, once stood 60 farms worked on by Japanese American families. These were stripped away by their unconstitutional incarceration during WWII.
