MARGIN OF ERROR

400 registered voters, selected at random from registered voter lists in the 8th congressional district, were interviewed October 4-9 by live, professional interviewers. 49% of the interviews were conducted on cell phones. The margin of sampling error is $\pm 5\%$ at the 95% level of confidence. This means, in theory, that had this same survey been conducted 100 times, the results would be within $\pm 5\%$ of the results reported here at least 95 times.
